1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. TRUNK HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION PROMOTING ECONOMIC
1.7	<b>DEVELOPMENT; APPROPRIATION, BONDING.</b>
1.8	Subdivision 1. <b>Appropriation.</b> \$100,000,000 is appropriated from the bond
1.9	proceeds account in the trunk highway fund to the commissioner of transportation for the
1.10	construction of trunk highways, where newly constructed roadway will promote economic
1.11	development, increase employment, relieve growing traffic congestion, and connect two or
1.12	more principal arterials. The amount under this subdivision must be allocated 50 percent
1.13	to the department's metropolitan district, and 50 percent to districts in greater Minnesota.
1.14	This appropriation is in addition to existing appropriations for the same purpose.
1.15	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the
1.16	bond proceeds account in the trunk highway fund, the commissioner of management and
1.17	budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$100,000,000 in the
1.18	manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections
1.19	167.50 to 167.52, and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XIV, section 11, at the times
1.20	and in the amounts requested by the commissioner of transportation. The proceeds of the
1.21	bonds, except accrued interest and any premium received from the sale of the bonds, must
1.22	be deposited in the bond proceeds account in the trunk highway fund.

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
