relating to public safety; providing immunity for individuals assisting another to seek medical assistance for a drug-related overdose; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 604A.05, subdivision 1.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 604A.05, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Subdivision 1. **Person seeking medical providing assistance; immunity from prosecution.** A person acting in good faith who seeks medical assistance for <u>or acts in</u>

<u>concert with a person seeking medical assistance for another person who is experiencing a drug-related overdose may not be charged or prosecuted for the possession, sharing, or use of a controlled substance under section 152.023, subdivision 2, <u>clauses (4) and (6)</u>, 152.024, or 152.025, <u>or possession of drug paraphernalia</u>. A person qualifies for the immunities provided in this subdivision only if:</u>

- (1) the evidence for the charge or prosecution was obtained as a result of the person's seeking medical assistance for <u>or acting in concert with a person seeking medical assistance</u> <u>for another person</u>; and
- (2) the person seeks medical assistance for <u>or acts in concert with a person seeking</u> <u>medical assistance for another person who is in need of medical assistance for an immediate</u> health or safety concern, provided that the person who seeks the medical assistance is the first person to seek the assistance, provides a name and contact information, remains on the scene until assistance arrives or is provided, and cooperates with the authorities.
- Good faith does not include seeking medical assistance during the course of the execution of an arrest warrant or search warrant or a lawful search.
