BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [340A.4075] CERTAIN VEHICLES FOR HIRE.

The commissioner may issue an on-sale intoxicating liquor license to the operator of a vehicle described in section 169A.35, subdivision 6, paragraph (a), clauses (1) to (3). A license issued under this section only authorizes the sale of intoxicating liquor to a bona

fide passenger who is actually being transported in interstate or intrastate commerce.
