- 1.8 Subd. 2e. **Local optional revenue.** (a) ~~For fiscal year 2021 and later,~~ Local optional
- 1.9 revenue for a school district equals the sum of the district's first tier, second tier, and third
- 1.10 tier of local optional revenue ~~and second tier local optional revenue.~~
- 1.11 (b) A district's first tier local optional revenue equals \$300 times the adjusted pupil units
- 1.12 of the district for that school year.
- 1.13 (c) A district's second tier local optional revenue equals \$424 times the adjusted pupil
- 1.14 units of the district for that school year.
- 1.15 (d) A district's third tier local optional revenue equals the lesser of:
- 1.16 (1) \$362 times the adjusted pupil units for that year; or
- 1.17 (2) the greater of zero or the product of the district's adjusted pupil units for the current

- 1.22 the first tier local optional levy and the second tier local optional levy.

~~(e)~~ (f) A district's first tier local optional levy equals the district's first tier local optional revenue times the lesser of one or the ratio of the district's referendum market value per resident pupil unit to \$880,000.

~~(d)~~ ~~For fiscal year 2022, a district's second tier local optional levy equals the district's second tier local optional revenue times the lesser of one or the ratio of the district's referendum market value per resident pupil unit to \$510,000.~~

(g) For fiscal year 2023, a district's second tier local optional levy equals the district's second tier local optional revenue times the lesser of one or the ratio of the district's referendum market value per resident pupil unit to \$548,842. For fiscal year 2024 and later, a district's second tier local optional levy equals the district's second tier local optional revenue times the lesser of one or the ratio of the district's referendum market value per resident pupil unit to \$510,000.

~~(e)~~ (h) The local optional levy must be spread on referendum market value. A district may levy less than the permitted amount.

~~(f)~~ (i) A district's local optional aid equals its local optional revenue minus its local optional levy. If a district's actual levy for first or second tier local optional revenue is less than its maximum levy limit for that tier, its aid must be proportionately reduced.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective for fiscal year 2023 and later.
