1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 18B.26, subdivision 6, is amended to read:

1.7Subd. 6. **Discontinuance or cancellation of registration.** (a) To ensure the complete

1.8withdrawal from distribution or further use of a pesticide, a person who intends to discontinue

1.9a pesticide registration must:

1.10(1) terminate a further distribution within the state and continue to register the pesticide

1.11annually for two successive years; and

1.12(2) initiate and complete a total recall of the pesticide from all distribution in the state

1.13within 60 days from the date of notification to the commissioner of intent to discontinue

1.14registration; ~~or.~~

1.15~~(3) submit to the commissioner evidence adequate to document that no distribution of~~

1.16~~the registered pesticide has occurred in the state.~~

1.17(b) Upon the request of a registrant, the commissioner may immediately cancel

1.18registration of a pesticide product. The commissioner may immediately cancel registration

1.19of a pesticide product at the commissioner's discretion. When requesting that the

1.20commissioner immediately cancel registration of a pesticide product, a registrant must

1.21provide the commissioner with:

1.22(1) a statement that the pesticide product is no longer in distribution; and

- 2.1 (2) documentation of pesticide gross sales from the previous year supporting the statement
