1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; FENCING CONSORTIUM.**

1.6\$5,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner

1.7of public safety for a grant to the Fencing Consortium for acquisition of anti-scale fencing,

1.8pedestrian doors, and vehicle gates for local government facilities statewide to improve

1.9equitable access to a de-escalation and safety tool. This appropriation is available until the

1.10project is completed or abandoned, subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.642. This is

1.11a onetime appropriation.

1.12**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
