BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION; FENCING CONSORTIUM.

\$5,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner 1.6 of public safety for a grant to the Fencing Consortium for acquisition of anti-scale fencing, 1.7 pedestrian doors, and vehicle gates for local government facilities statewide to improve 1.8 equitable access to a de-escalation and safety tool. This appropriation is available until the 1.9 project is completed or abandoned, subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.642. This is 1.10 a onetime appropriation. 1.11
