1.4	Section 1. PRIVATE SALE OF TAX-FORFEITED LAND; LAKE COUNTY.
1.5	(a) Notwithstanding the public sale provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282,
1.6	or other law to the contrary, Lake County may sell by private sale the tax-forfeited land
1.7	described in paragraph (c).
1.8	(b) The conveyance must be in a form approved by the attorney general. The attorney
1.9	general may make changes to the land description to correct errors and ensure accuracy.
1.10	(c) The land to be sold is located in Lake County and is described as:
1.11	(1) an 1/2 undivided interest in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter,
1.12	Section 19, Township 63 North, Range 11 West; and
1.13	(2) the West 330 feet of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, Section 4,
