\$1,148,250 in fiscal year 2021 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the Northeast Entrepreneur Fund, a small business administration microlender and community development financial institution operating in northern Minnesota, to be made only upon the Northeast Entrepreneur Fund's repayment of its current \$1,148,250 loan issued by the commissioner. Grant funds must be used as capital for accessing additional federal lending for small businesses impacted by COVID-19 and must be returned to the commissioner for deposit in the general fund if the Northeast Entrepreneur Fund fails to secure such federal funds before January 1, 2022. This is a onetime appropriation.
