1.7BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.8Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 353G.08, is amended by adding a

1.9subdivision to read:

1.10Subd. 2a. **Additional municipal contributions authorized.** (a) At the discretion of

1.11the municipality or the independent nonprofit firefighting corporation associated with a fire

1.12department covered by a voluntary statewide lump-sum volunteer firefighter retirement

1.13plan account, the municipality or the corporation may make additional contributions

1.14to the applicable account.

1.15(b) The executive director of the Public Employees Retirement Association

1.16may specify requirements as to the form, timing, and accompanying information for

1.17contributions made under this subdivision.

1.18(c) Any contributions made under this subdivision must be included as total present

1.19assets of the account for the calculation of any subsequent annual funding requirements

1.20for the account under subdivision 1 or for the calculation of any cash flow funding

1.21requirement under subdivision 2.
