1.7	An amendment to the Minnesota Constitution is proposed to the people. If the
1.8	amendment is adopted, article IV, section 4, will read:
1.9	Sec. 4. Representatives shall be chosen for a term of two four years, except to fill a
1.10	vacancy-, and senators shall be chosen for a term of four six years, except to fill a vacancy
1.11	and except as otherwise required by this section. There shall be an entire new election
1.12	of all the senators and representatives at the first general election of representatives after
1.13	each new legislative apportionment provided for in this article. The governor shall call
