1.2relating to public safety; prohibiting police officers from issuing speeding tickets

1.3for speeds under 55 miles per hour on marked Interstate Highway 35E in St. Paul;

1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 169.14, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7to read:

1.8Subd. 5g. **Interstate Highway 35E.** (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, a police

1.9officer must not issue any citation or warning to a driver for a violation of the speed limit

1.10of 45 miles per hour on marked Interstate Highway 35E in the city of St. Paul, from its

1.11intersection with West Seventh Street to its intersection with marked Interstate Highway

1.1294, unless the violation consisted of a speed greater than ten miles per hour in excess of the

1.13speed limit.

1.14(b) This subdivision does not apply to (1) a violation that occurs in a commercial motor

1.15vehicle, or (2) a violation committed by a holder of a class A, B, or C commercial driver's

1.16license, regardless of whether the violation was committed in a commercial motor vehicle.
