1.4	Section 1. OPENHOUSE CASE MISSIONS DEDUCTION STDATECY, DEDODT
1.4	Section 1. GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS REDUCTION STRATEGY; REPORT.
1.5	(a) The commissioner of commerce must develop benchmarks and strategies designed
1.6	to significantly accelerate the reduction in greenhouse gas emissions in Minnesota by 2030,
1.7	including strategies to:
1.8	(1) increase energy efficiency in all buildings, including residential buildings;
1.9	(2) provide consumers with tools to manage energy use automatically, remotely, and
1.10	electronically;
1.11	(3) present consumers with financial incentives to shift energy use to periods when
1.12	systemwide demand and the cost of generation are low;
1.13	(4) electrify all sectors of the economy currently powered by fossil fuels;
1.14	(5) increase carbon sequestration in Minnesota lands and wetlands;
1.15	(6) incentivize the adoption of energy storage systems to accelerate the use of wind and
1.16	solar resources; and
1.17	(7) modernize the electric grid and promote the use of distributed energy resources.
1.18	(b) By November 30, 2019, the commissioner shall submit a report containing the
1.19	benchmarks and strategies to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative
1.20	committees with primary jurisdiction over energy policy.
