OUTDOOR FIRING RANGE TRAINING FACILITY; MAPLEWOOD. 1.6 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$1,965,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund 1.7 to the commissioner of public safety for a grant to the city of St. Paul to construct sound 1.8 mitigation barriers at an existing outdoor firing range in Maplewood for law enforcement 1.9 training.
