BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

## Section 1. APPROPRIATION FOR ADVANCED CARE PLANNING.

\$500,000 in fiscal year 2018 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of health to award a grant to a statewide advanced care planning resource organization that has expertise in convening and coordinating community-based strategies to encourage individuals, families, caregivers, and health care providers to begin conversations regarding end-of-life care choices that express an individual's health care values and preferences and are based on informed health care decisions. \$500,000 is added to the base appropriation beginning in fiscal year 2019 and continuing in each fiscal year thereafter for grants for advanced care planning.
