1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. GLACIAL LAKES TRAIL.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$2,590,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.7	to the commissioner of natural resources to acquire land and develop an approximately
1.8	five-mile spur from the Glacial Lakes Trail through New London and into Sibley State Park,
1.9	including a separated grade crossing of Trunk Highway 71 and a separated grade crossing
1.10	of County Highway 40.
1.11	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the bond
1.12	proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.13	the state in an amount up to \$2,590,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.14	prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.15	Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
