1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 10A.04, subdivision 6, is amended to read
1.6	Subd. 6. Principal reports. (a) A principal must report to the board as required in
1.7	this subdivision by March 15 for the preceding calendar year.
1.8	(b) The principal must report the total amount, rounded to the nearest \$20,000,
1.9	spent by the principal during the preceding calendar year to influence legislative action,
1.10	administrative action, and the official action of metropolitan governmental units. For
1.11	purposes of this report, administrative action does not include the application or
1.12	administration of an adopted rule.
1.13	(c) The principal must report under this subdivision a total amount that includes:
1.14	(1) all direct payments by the principal to lobbyists in this state;
1.15	(2) all expenditures for advertising, mailing, research, analysis, compilation and
1.16	dissemination of information, and public relations campaigns related to legislative action,
1.17	administrative action, or the official action of metropolitan governmental units in this
1.18	state; and
1.19	(3) all salaries and administrative expenses attributable to activities of the principal
1.20	relating to efforts to influence legislative action, administrative action, or the official

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action of metropolitan governmental units in this state.
