1.2 relating to state government; adding the commissioner of human rights to the
1.3 urban initiative board; amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 116M.15,
1.4 subdivision 1.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 116M.15, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.7 Subdivision 1. **Creation; membership.** The Urban Initiative Board is created and
1.8 consists of the commissioner of employment and economic development, the commissioner
1.9 of human rights, the chair of the Metropolitan Council, and eight members from the general
1.10 public appointed by the governor. Six of the public members must be representatives from
1.11 minority business enterprises. No more than four of the public members may be of one
1.12 gender. All public members must be experienced in business or economic development.
