1.2 relating to state government; creating technology and cyber security fund; proposing
1.3 coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 5.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. 5.42] TECHNOLOGY AND CYBER SECURITY FUND.

1.6 Subdivision 1. Definitions. For the purposes of this section, the terms defined in this
1.7 subdivision have the meanings given them:

1.8 (a) "information and telecommunications technology systems and services" has the
1.9 meaning given in section 16E.03, subdivision 1, paragraph (a).

1.10 (b) "cyber security" has the meaning given in section 16E.03, subdivision 1, paragraph
1.11 (d).

1.12 Subd. 2. Special revenue fund. (a) The secretary of state may retain two percent of all
1.13 statutory fees collected by the secretary of state for expenditures related to maintenance and
1.14 enhancement of the secretary of state's information and telecommunications technology
1.15 systems and services, and of the secretary of state's cyber security.

1.16 (b) Funds received under this subdivision must be deposited in an account in the special
1.17 revenue fund and are appropriated to the secretary of state for the purposes in this subdivision.
