1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Laws 2006, chapter 269, section 2, as amended by Laws 2008, chapter 331,
1.7 section 11, and Laws 2008, chapter 366, article 17, section 5, is amended to read:

1.8 Sec. 2. **DEDICATION FEE.**

1.9 The Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board and the Minneapolis City Council
1.10 may jointly ~~exercise the powers conferred under Minnesota Statutes, section 462.358,~~
1.11 ~~with respect to requiring~~ require that a reasonable portion of land be dedicated to the
1.12 public or ~~imposing~~ impose a dedication fee ~~on~~ in conjunction with the construction permit
1.13 required for new housing units and new commercial and industrial development in the
1.14 city, wherever located, for public parks, playgrounds, recreational facilities, wetlands,
1.15 trails, or open space. The dedication of land or dedication fee must be imposed by an
1.16 ordinance jointly enacted by the park board and the city council. The cash fee may be set
1.17 at a flat fee rate per net new residential unit. The ordinance may exclude senior housing
1.18 and affordable housing from paying the fee or the dedication of land. The provisions of
1.19 Minnesota Statutes, section 462.358, subdivisions 2b, paragraph (b), and 2c, apply to the
1.20 ~~imposition, application, and~~ use of the dedication of land or the dedication fee.

1.21 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2013, upon compliance
1.22 by the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board and the Minneapolis City Council with
1.23 Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021, subdivision 3, and applies to previously enacted

- 2.1 park dedication fee ordinances of the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board and the
- 2.2 Minneapolis City Council as of that date.
