1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 160.295, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 5. **Rural agricultural business or tourist-oriented business.** (a) A rural

1.7 agricultural or tourist-oriented business serviced by a specific service sign must be open a

1.8 minimum of eight hours per day, six days per week, and 12 months per year. ~~However,~~

1.9 (b) A seasonal business may qualify if it is serviced by a specific service sign must be

1.10 open eight hours per day and six days per week during the normal seasonal period.

1.11 (c) A farm winery serviced by a specific service sign must:

1.12 (1) be licensed under section 340A.315;

1.13 (2) be licensed by the Department of Health under section 157.16;

1.14 (3) provide continuous, staffed food service operation; and

1.15 (4) be open at least four hours per day and two days per week.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
