1.8	Subdivision 1. <b>Appropriation.</b> \$1,174,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9	fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city
1.10	of Silver Bay to demolish a multiuse recreation building in Silver Bay and to predesign,
1.11	design, construct, furnish, and equip a municipal campground and new multiuse recreation
