1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to education finance; increasing home visiting revenue for school
1.3 districts; amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 124D.135, subdivision 6.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 124D.135, subdivision 6, is amended to
1.6 read:

1.7 Subd. 6. **Home visiting levy revenue.** A district that is eligible to levy for early
1.8 childhood family education under subdivision 3 and that enters into a collaborative
1.9 agreement to provide education services and social services to families with young
1.10 children ~~may~~ is eligible for home visiting revenue consisting of its home visiting aid and
1.11 its home visiting levy. A district's home visiting aid equals \$1.32 times the number of
1.12 people under five years of age residing in the district on September 1 of the last school
1.13 year. A district's home visiting levy ~~an amount equal to \$1.60~~ equals \$1.32 times the
1.14 number of people under five years of age residing in the district on September 1 of the last
1.15 school year. Levy revenue under this subdivision must not be included as revenue under
1.16 subdivision 1. ~~The~~ Home visiting revenue must be used for home visiting programs under
1.17 section 124D.13, subdivision 4.

1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for revenue for fiscal year 2018
1.19 and later.
