1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. ST. PAUL; WAKAN TIPI CENTER.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$3,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.7	to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of
1.8	Saint Paul to predesign, design, furnish, and equip Wakan Tipi Center in the Bruce Vento
1.9	Nature Sanctuary in St. Paul that will be used for uses and programs that the city determines
1.10	meet regional and city park purpose requirements. The city may enter into a lease or
1.11	management agreement under Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.695, to operate the programs
1.12	in the center. This appropriation is not available until the commissioner of management and
1.13	budget determines that at least an equal amount is committed to the project from nonstate

1.15	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
