	Section 1. MARTIN TOWNSHIP ROAD RECONSTRUCTION; APPROPRIATION

	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds account
1	in the state transportation fund under Minnesota Statutes, section 174.50, to the commissioner
(of transportation for a grant to Martin Township in Rock County, for design, engineering,
•	and reconstruction of a segment of 41st Street from the intersection with Rock County
()	State-Aid Highway 6, also known as 60th Avenue, to a location approximately one mile
1	westerly and in the vicinity of the highway-rail grade crossing.
	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the bond
]	proceeds account in the state transportation fund, the commissioner of management and
1	budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$500,000 in the manner,
1	upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to
	16A.675, and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7. The proceeds of
1	the bonds, except accrued interest and any premium received on the sale of the bonds, must
1	be credited to the bond proceeds account in the state transportation fund.
