A bill for an act  
relating to job creation; imposing a temporary moratorium on state agency  
rulemaking.  
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **RULEMAKING MORATORIUM.**

(a) For purposes of this section, "agency" has the meaning given in Minnesota  
Statutes, section 14.02, subdivision 2.

(b) No agency shall conduct rulemaking or adopt rules for the two-year period  
beginning July 1, 2012, and ending June 30, 2014, except under the following  
circumstances:

- (1) to implement a federal law;
- (2) in relation to a declared state of emergency;
- (3) to respond to an emergency relating to public health or safety;
- (4) as enacted by the legislature; or
- (5) to facilitate commerce.

(c) This section does not prohibit an agency from repealing rules.

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
