1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. APPROPRIATION.

1.6\$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2022 and \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 are appropriated from

1.7the general fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant

1.8to Comunidades Latinas Unidas En Servicio-Latino Communities United in Service (CLUES)

1.9to address employment and economic disparities for low-income unemployed or

1.10underemployed individuals. Funds must support short-term certifications and transferable

1.11skills in high-demand fields, workforce readiness, customized financial capability, and

1.12employment services. At least 50 percent of this amount must be used for programming

1.13targeted at Greater Minnesota.
