1.1A bill for an act

1.2relating to capital investment; appropriating money for a Black Beach campground

1.3in Silver Bay; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. **BLACK BEACH MUNICIPAL CAMPGROUND; SILVER BAY.**

1.6Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$1,708,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund

1.7to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of

1.8Silver Bay to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip a campground adjacent to the

1.9Black Beach recreational beach in Silver Bay, including camping sites; electrical, water,

1.10and sewer infrastructure; a playground; a pavilion; lavatory vaults; a shower and lavatory

1.11building; and a main office building. This appropriation may also be used to design, construct,

1.12furnish, and equip a walking trail from the campground to the Black Beach recreational

1.13site. This appropriation is not available until \$548,000 is committed from nonstate sources.

1.14The nonstate contribution may be in kind. In-kind contributions may include the value of

1.15site preparation.

1.16Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this act from the bond proceeds

1.17fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state

1.18in an amount up to \$1,708,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed

1.19by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota Constitution,

1.20article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.21**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
