- 1.2 relating to public safety; eliminating the exclusion from fifth degree criminal sexual
- 1.3 conduct for nonconsensual, intentional touching of another person's clothed buttock;
- 1.4 amending Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 609.3451, subdivision 1.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 609.3451, subdivision 1, is amended to read:
- 1.7 Subdivision 1. **Crime defined.** A person is guilty of criminal sexual conduct in the fifth
- 1.8 degree:
- 1.9 (1) if the person engages in nonconsensual sexual contact; or
- 1.10 (2) the person engages in masturbation or lewd exhibition of the genitals in the presence
- 1.11 of a minor under the age of 16, knowing or having reason to know the minor is present.
- 1.12 For purposes of this section, "sexual contact" has the meaning given in section 609.341,
- 1.13 subdivision 11, paragraph (a), clauses (i), (iv), and (v), ~~but does not include the intentional~~
- 1.14 ~~touching of the clothing covering the immediate area of the buttocks.~~ Sexual contact also
- 1.15 includes the intentional removal or attempted removal of clothing covering the complainant's
- 1.16 intimate parts or undergarments, and the nonconsensual touching by the complainant of the
- 1.17 actor's intimate parts, effected by the actor, if the action is performed with sexual or
- 1.18 aggressive intent.
