1.7BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.11**Road J Interchange**1,500,000

1.12From the bond proceeds account in the state

1.24**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

2.1       Sec. 2. **CENTERVILLE ROAD, COUNTY ROAD J, AND I-35E INTERCHANGE**  
2.2 **IMPROVEMENTS; RAMSEY COUNTY.**

2.3       Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$14,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds  
2.4 account in the state transportation fund to the commissioner of transportation for one or  
2.5 more grants to Ramsey County or Anoka County for reconstruction of transportation  
2.6 improvements to Centerville Road, County Road J, Otter Lake Road, the Interstate Highway  
2.7 35E interchange, and approach streets to support the reconstruction of these roadways in  
2.8 the cities of North Oaks, Lino Lakes, and White Bear Township.

2.9       Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond  
2.10 proceeds account in the state transportation fund, the commissioner of management and  
2.11 budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$14,000,000 in the manner,  
2.12 upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to  
2.13 16A.675, and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7, at the times and in  
2.14 the amounts requested by the commissioner of transportation.

2.15       **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
