1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[299A.85] COORDINATION WITH DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND**
1.7 **SECURITY.**

1.8 When an individual becomes eligible for release from the custody of a state or local law
1.9 enforcement agency and the Department of Homeland Security has issued an immigration
1.10 detainer under Code of Federal Regulations, title 8, section 287.7, paragraph (d), the state
1.11 or local law enforcement agency shall maintain custody of the individual for a period not
1.12 to exceed 48 hours, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays in order to permit the
1.13 assumption of custody of the individual by the Department of Homeland Security, regardless
1.14 of whether the individual is eligible for bail.
