1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT FOR**

1.6 **COMMUNITIES OF COLOR.**

1.7 \$4,200,000 in fiscal year 2020 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner

1.8 of human services to award grants to eligible applicants for projects directed at providing

1.9 mental health treatment for communities of color. The grant recipients shall utilize

1.10 evidence-based intergenerational models of healing to create new strategies to effectively

1.11 serve low-income communities of color. This is a onetime appropriation and the funds are

1.12 available until expended.
