1.1A bill for an act

1.2relating to capital investment; appropriating money for an interchange or

1.3intersection and associated improvements on 109th Avenue Northeast at marked

1.4Trunk Highway 65 in Blaine; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. **BLAINE; 109TH AVENUE NORTHEAST AT MARKED TRUNK**

1.7**HIGHWAY 65.**

1.8Subdivision 1. **Trunk Highway 65 interchange; appropriation.** (a) \$85,000,000 in

1.9fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of transportation

1.10for one or more grants to the county of Anoka, the city of Blaine, or both, for construction

1.11of a local road interchange or intersection improvements at Anoka County State-Aid Highway

1.1212, known as 109th Avenue Northeast, and marked Trunk Highway 65, including any

1.13associated: (1) local road improvements; (2) frontage roads; and (3) water and sanitary

1.14sewer infrastructure improvements necessary for the construction. This is a onetime

1.15appropriation and is available until June 30, 2025.

1.16(b) Upon written notice to the commissioner of management and budget, any unspent

1.17portion of this appropriation remaining after completion of the project is available for any

1.18other interchange or intersection improvement projects on local roads that intersect marked

1.19Trunk Highway 65 in Spring Lake Park, Blaine, or Ham Lake.

1.20Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the bond

1.21proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of

1.22the state in an amount up to \$85,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

- 2.1 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 2.2 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
- 2.3 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
