1.5	Section 1. BROADBAND INFRASTRUCTURE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
1.6	DEMONSTRATION PROJECT; APPROPRIATION.
1.7	(a) \$2,400,000 is appropriated in fiscal year 2016 from the border-to-border
1.8	broadband infrastructure fund under Minnesota Statutes, section 116J.396, to the
1.9	commissioner of employment and economic development to award a grant to a city to
1.10	pay for broadband infrastructure and other eligible expenses, as identified in Minnesota
1.11	Statutes, section 116J.395, subdivision 2, for a wire-line broadband infrastructure
1.12	demonstration project that is part of a public-private partnership.
1.13	(b) In order to be awarded the grant under paragraph (a), a city must demonstrate:
1.14	(1) funding from nonstate sources that matches the amount appropriated in
1.15	paragraph (a);
1.16	(2) broadband service outages of 12 hours or more in the area within its jurisdiction;
1.17	(3) a decline in the number of businesses in the area within its jurisdiction, as a result
1.18	of the lack of adequate broadband service; and
1.19	(4) an agreement that the city will own the broadband infrastructure as part of the
1.20	public-private partnership.
1.21	(c) The commissioner of employment and economic development must award the
1.22	grant under this section before September 1, 2015.
