1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 58.18, subdivision 1, is amended to read:
1.7	Subdivision 1. Remedies. A borrower injured by a violation of the standards, duties,
1.8	prohibitions, or requirements of sections 58.13, 58.136, 58.137, 58.16, and 58.161, and
1.9	58.19 shall have a private right of action and the court shall award:
1.10	(1) actual, incidental, and consequential damages;
1.11	(2) statutory damages equal to the amount of all lender fees included in the amount of
1.12	the principal of the residential mortgage loan as defined in section 58.137;
1.13	(3) punitive damages if appropriate, and as provided in sections 549.191 and 549.20;
1.14	and
1.15	(4) court costs and reasonable attorney fees.
1.16	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective August 1, 2018, and applies to actions
1.17	arising from incidents occurring on or after that date.
