1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for a Latino Community
1.3 Outreach Center.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. APPROPRIATION; REBUILDING LAKE STREET MINNEAPOLIS;
1.6 LATINO COMMUNITY OUTREACH CENTER.

1.7 \$10,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
1.8 of employment and economic development for a grant to Comunidades Latinas Unidas en
1.9 Servicio (CLUES) to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip a new Latino outreach
1.10 facility at 2800 East Lake Street, Minneapolis. The new Economic Opportunity and Wellness
1.11 Hub will provide workforce training, business incubators and technical assistance, a youth
1.12 technology center, behavioral health clinics, a food shelf, child care, and other high-demand
1.13 community supports. The project must include a nonstate funding match of no less than
1.14 \$8,000,000. This is a onetime appropriation and is available until the project is completed
1.15 or abandoned, subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.642.

1.16 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
