1.5	Section 1. AMATEUR SPORTS COMMISSION; RUGBY FIELDS AND
1.6	<u>CLUBHOUSE.</u>
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$4,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8	to the Minnesota Amateur Sports Commission to design, construct, and equip rugby fields
1.9	at the National Sports Center in Blaine. This appropriation includes money for site
1.10	preparation, drainage improvements, and scoreboards.
1.11	Subd. 2. Appropriation. \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to
1.12	the Minnesota Amateur Sports Commission to design, construct, furnish, and equip an
1.13	integrated clubhouse at the National Sports Center in Blaine.
1.14	Subd. 3. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.15	proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.16	the state in an amount up to \$14,500,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.17	prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota

1.19	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
