1.5	Section 1. OLMSTED COUNTY; SOUTHEAST REGIONAL EMERGENCY YOUTH
1.6	SHELTER.
1.7	Subdivision 1. <b>Appropriation.</b> \$5,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8	to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Olmsted
1.9	County to construct, furnish, and equip improvements for renovation of the Southeast
1.10	Minnesota Regional Emergency Youth Shelter Facility located in Olmsted County to ensure
1.11	the continuation of shelter and case management along with educational and employment
1.12	services for youth in southern Minnesota. The county may enter into a lease or management
