fire-extinguishing equipment or devices in any new or existing single-family detached
dwelling unit, two-family dwelling unit, townhome, or accessory structure such as a gara
covered patio, deck, porch, storage shed, or similar structure.
(b) This subdivision does not affect or limit a requirement for smoke or fire detector
