Turn clothes inside out as soon as possible after using the field to avoid tracking dust 1.15 and infill to other locations. 1.16 3. Keep beverages closed and in bags or coolers when not drinking to minimize 1.17 contamination from field dust and fibers. 1.18 4. Be aware of signs of heat-related illness and dehydration. Fields can get excessively 1.19 hot on warm, sunny days. Take all necessary precautions." 1.20
