1.11	effective and efficient in communicating to the persons appearing to be owners of this
1.12	property. Public notice may include the use of print, broadcast, or electronic media. The
1.13	commissioner shall, at a minimum, expend 15 percent of the funds allocated by the legislature
1.14	to the operations of the unclaimed property division, to comply with the public notice
1.15	requirements of this subdivision section and shall report to the legislature annually on how
1.16	those funds are expended.
