- 1.8 The commissioner shall not approve a contract for, or grant state funds for, a capital
- 1.9 improvement project to construct or renovate a building unless the project includes
- 1.10 equipping public meeting rooms, auditoriums, arenas, or other public gathering space in
- 1.11 the building with audio-induction loops to provide an electromagnetic signal for hearing
- 1.12 <u>aids and cochlear implants, and with radio frequency transmitters to broadcast a radio</u>
- 1.13 signal to dedicated receivers to be used to assist the hearing impaired.
- 1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2015, and applies to
- 1.15 contracts entered into and grants made after that date.
