# 1.5 Section 1. EARNED COMPLIANCE CREDIT STUDY; REPORT REQUIRED.

# 1.6 (a) The commissioner of corrections shall study and make recommendations to

# 1.7 <u>the legislature on the issue of implementing an earned compliance credit policy for</u>

#### 1.8 offenders on probation and supervised release. The commissioner shall use the language

#### 1.9 of S.F. No. 2667, as introduced in the 2016 legislative session, as the starting point for

# 1.10 the study. The commissioner shall consult with practitioners with experience in this area

#### 1.11 when conducting the study and shall attempt to take the opinions of those practitioners

# 1.12 into account when making the required recommendations.

# 1.13 (b) By January 15, 2017, the commissioner shall report the results of the study and

# 1.14 any related recommendations to the chairs and ranking minority members of the senate

# 1.15 and house of representatives committees having jurisdiction over criminal justice policy.
