1.6	Subdivision 1. Issuance of plates. The commissioner must issue Civil Air Patrol special
1.7	plates or a single motorcycle plate to an applicant who:
1.8	(1) is a registered owner of a passenger automobile, noncommercial one-ton pickup
1.9	truck, motorcycle, or recreational vehicle;
1.10	(2) provides a letter from a Civil Air Patrol commander affirming that the applicant is
1.11	a member in good standing;
1.12	(3) pays the registration tax as required under section 168.013;
1.13	(4) pays a fee in the amount specified under section 168.12, subdivision 5, for each set
1.14	of plates, along with any other fees required by this chapter; and
1.15	(5) complies with this chapter and rules governing registration of motor vehicles and
1.16	licensing of drivers.
1.17	Subd. 2. Design. The commissioner must adopt a suitable design for the plate in
1.18	consultation with the Civil Air Patrol.
1.19	Subd. 3. Plates transfer. On application to the commissioner and payment of a transfer
1.20	fee of \$5, special plates issued under this section may be transferred to another motor vehicle
