1.6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 221.091, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

- Subd. 2. **Small vehicle passenger service.** (a) A city that licenses and regulates small vehicle passenger service must do so by ordinance. The ordinance must, at a minimum, provide for driver qualifications, insurance, vehicle safety, and periodic vehicle inspections.
- (b) A city that has adopted an ordinance complying with this subdivision may enforce the registration requirement in section 221.021.
- (c) A statutory or home rule charter city that regulates, by ordinance, pedicabs, rickshaws, or other similar vehicles used for passenger service may permit authorized vehicles to be equipped with an electric motor that meets the requirements for an electric-assisted bicycle under section 169.011, subdivision 27, clause (3).

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
