1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. Laws 2018, chapter 214, article 1, section 21, subdivision 28, as amended by

1.7Laws 2019, chapter 2, article 2, section 6, is amended to read:

1.8Subd. 28. **St. Paul - Southeast Asian Language**

1.9**Job Training Facilities**5,500,000

1.10For a grant to the city of St. Paul to predesign,

1.11design, renovate, construct, furnish, and equip

1.12a bus driver and mechanics training facility

1.13on Sycamore Street in St. Paul for training

1.14drivers and mechanics through programming

1.15primarily in the Southeast Asian languages,

1.16and to predesign, design, renovate, construct,

1.17furnish, and equip a training facility on Plato

1.18Avenue in St. Paul for use as a training facility

1.19for health care, manufacturing, and

1.20information technology jobs through

1.21programming primarily in the Southeast Asian

1.22languages. Notwithstanding the primary focus

1.23as a workforce training facility described

1.24above, a portion of the Plato site may be used

2.1 for colocated high school and child care
2.2 facilities open to the public. A portion of both
2.3 the Plato and Sycamore sites may include
2.4 on-site wrap-around supportive services to
2.5 assist the participants in training programs in
2.6 securing housing, mental health, adult basic
2.7 education, and health care enrollment and
2.8 access. This appropriation may be used to
2.9 acquire property for these purposes. The city
2.10 of St. Paul may enter into a lease or
2.11 management agreement with a nonprofit
2.12 corporation for either or both of these facilities
2.13 under Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.695.

2.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
