1.1 A bill for an act

relating to transportation; modifying the state rail safety inspection program; amending Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 219.015, subdivision 1.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 219.015, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Subdivision 1. Positions Program established; inspector powers and duties. (a) The commissioner of transportation shall must establish three a state rail safety inspector positions in the Office of Freight and Commercial Vehicle Operations of the Minnesota Department of Transportation. On or after July 1, 2015, the commissioner may establish a fourth state rail safety inspector position following consultation with railroad companies inspection program consisting of up to six positions, which may include state rail safety inspectors and a program supervisor. The commissioner shall apply to and enter into agreements with the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) of the United States Department of Transportation to participate in the federal State Rail Safety Participation Program for training and eertification of an inspector to train and certify inspectors under authority of United States Code, title 49, sections 20103, 20105, 20106, and 20113, and Code of Federal Regulations, title 49, part 212.

- (b) A state rail safety inspector shall may:
- (1) inspect mainline track, secondary track, and yard and industry track;
- 1.20 (2) inspect railroad right-of-way, including adjacent or intersecting drainage, culverts, 1.21 bridges, overhead structures, and traffic and other public crossings;
