OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to transportation; requiring rulemaking on collecting certain demographic  
1.3 information on driver's license holders; appropriating money; amending Minnesota  
1.4 Statutes 2020, section 171.12, by adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 171.12, is amended by adding a subdivision  
1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 11. Demographic information. (a) The commissioner must adopt rules to collect  
1.9 and maintain demographic information on race and ethnicity for each person who holds a  
1.10 driver's license.

1.11 (b) The limitation under section 171.015, subdivision 7, does not apply to the extent  
1.12 necessary to implement the requirements of this section.

1.13 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.

1.14 Sec. 2. DEMOGRAPHIC DATA RULEMAKING; APPROPRIATION.

1.15 \$..... in fiscal year 2022 is appropriated from the driver services operating account in  
1.16 the special revenue fund to the commissioner of public safety for rulemaking under Minnesota  
1.17 Statutes, section 171.12, subdivision 11. This is a onetime appropriation and is available  
1.18 until June 30, 2023.

1.19 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
