1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; HUBERT H. HUMPHREY STATUE.**

1.6\$200,000 in fiscal year 2025 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner

1.7of administration to replace the statue of Henry Mower Rice in the Statutory Hall in the

1.8United States Capitol with a statue of Hubert H. Humphrey. This appropriation includes

1.9money for the removal and transportation of the Henry Mower Rice statue to the Minnesota

1.10State Historical Society, the recasting of the statue of Hubert H. Humphrey that currently

1.11stands on the mall of the Minnesota State Capitol, and the erection of the new Hubert H.

1.12Humphrey statue in the Statutory Hall in the United States Capitol. This appropriation is

1.13onetime and is available until the project is completed or abandoned, subject to Minnesota

1.14Statutes, section 16A.642.

1.15**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
