BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

## Section 1. APPROPRIATION; WATER QUALITY ENHANCEMENT CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PILOT PROGRAM.

\$100,000 in fiscal year 2012 and \$100,000 in fiscal year 2013 are appropriated from the clean water fund to the Pollution Control Agency for grants to the Star Lake Board established under Minnesota Statutes, section 103B.702. The pilot program shall focus on citizen partnerships with the Pollution Control Agency to develop and implement pollution prevention lake and watershed management plans and designating said waters as star lakes and rivers. The Star Lake Board may spend grant money received under this section only as provided in a work program approved by the commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency. The board shall include information on the results of the pilot program in its next biennial report under Minnesota Statutes, section 103B.702. This is a onetime appropriation.
